Project Location (include county): The project is located at Grizzly Slough tributary to the Cosumnes River, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.24547, Longitude -121.40239 or Section 26, Township 5N, Range 5E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Bruceville and Thornton, at New Hope Road in Thornton, CA; Assessor's Parcel Number 146-0140-004-0000, 146-0140-005-0000, 146-0140-017-0000, 146-0140-018-0000, 146-0140-020-0000, and 146-0140-021-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2019-0087-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Water Resources.

Amendment 1 modifies the levee breach along Grizzly Slough by shifting it south by approximately 200 feet, modified the 1000 feet of the northern-most segment of the main restoration tidal channel to be realigned approximately 400 feet west, added a new low berm with drainage outlet (one-directional-flow culvert(s)) along the eastern edge of the realigned tidal channel segment, added approximately 3,300 feet of additional tidal channel in the central area of the project (in upland agricultural lands), and revised permanent project impacts to habitat to reflect an overall decrease in impacts and an overall increase in total habitat creation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-mentioned Amendment to the Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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- 2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
- 3. Mitigation measures were made as a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
- 4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
