Project Title: Talone Lake Habitat Restoration Project - 2020

Project Applicant: Talone Lake Conservancy

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Talone Lake, adjacent to State Route 76, north of Frazee Road, east of College Boulevard, in the City of Oceanside, in the County of San Diego, State of California; Latitude 33.23900, Longitude -117.29440; Assessor's Parcel Number 161-551-22-00.

Project Description: CDFW is intending to execute a Streambed Alteration Agreement pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code (# EPIMS-SDO-13606-R5) to the project applicant, Talone Lake Conservancy. The project proposes to temporarily impact 1.0 acre of Diegan coastal sage scrub (staging area), 4.88 acres of freshwater marsh, and 0.12 acre of open water to remove a monoculture of cattails and stagnant water that currently serves as mosquito breeding habitat and allow a mosaic of open water, freshwater marsh, and riparian forest habitat to redevelop.


This is to advise that the CDFW acting as a Lead agency / Responsible agency has approved the above described project on March 1, 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
