Project Title: Amendment to the 2018 Long Range Development Plan to Address Impacts on Crotch's Bumble Bee and the West Village Open Space Improvements Project

Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Crotch's bumble bee (*Bombus crotchii*) was designated as a candidate for listing as endangered under the California Endangered Species Act after certification of the UC Davis 2018 Long Range Development Plan (2018 LRDP) environmental impact report (EIR) (State Clearinghouse No. 2017012008). UC Davis intends to adopt a Subsequent mitigated negative declaration (MND), supported by an Initial Study to evaluate an Amendment to the 2018 LRDP to address impacts on Crotch's bumble bee due to the implementation of projects on the UC Davis campus. In addition, the West Village Open Space Improvements Project is evaluated and found to be within the scope of the 2018 LRDP EIR, as amended to include mitigation measures addressing Crotch's bumble bee. No other changes to the UC Davis LRDP are planned or considered.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Implementation of the new 2018 LRDP EIR Mitigation Measure 3.5-13 in this IS/MND would reduce the potential impact of the LRDP on Crotch's bumble bee to a less-than-significant level by requiring a habitat assessment for Crotch's bumble bee, implementation of a limited operating period during the Crotch's bumble bee colony active period (April through August) during which initial ground-disturbing activities for future projects under the 2018 LRDP would not occur, focused surveys for bumble bees, and implementation of measures to avoid mortality of the Crotch's bumble bees if nests are detected.

With the incorporation of mitigation measures from the 2018 LRDP EIR and MMRP, as revised to include mitigation in this IS/MND, the West Village Open Space Improvements Project would result in less-than-significant impacts on aesthetics, air quality, biological, cultural and tribal cultural resources, geology and soils, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, noise, and transportation and circulation.
