Project Title: Mariposa Road Logisticenter (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SJN-30359-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Littlejohns Creek, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.915725, Longitude -121.201129 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-30359-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Dermody Properties Maple Leaf Mariposa Road, LLC as represented by Karsen Keever.

The project is limited to the installation of three (3) utility lines under Littlejohns Creek to accommodate the future development of a 61-acre site northeast of the project location.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
