Title: Seasonal Bridge across the Eel River at Dinner Bar

Applicant: Humboldt Redwood Company, LLC

Location: Sovereign land in the Eel River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 205-061-004 and 205-341-019, near Scotia, Humboldt County

Description: The Project involves annual placement of a seasonal bridge crossing the Eel River. The bridge crossing is used to transport gravel removed during the Applicant's annual summer gravel extraction operations that are conducted outside of the active channel of the Eel River. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 10-year General Lease – Right-of-Way through August 14, 2034.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on August 29, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, Humboldt County (County), adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on May 23, 1996. The County adopted an Addendum to the MND on September 6, 2012, to address the renewal of the Eel River Gravel Bars Reclamation Plan. The California State Lands Commission has previously considered the MND and Addendum to the MND, as adopted for this project, and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program that incorporates the previous documents, which remains in full force. The MND, Addendum to the MND, and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
