Project Title: Crimson Solar Project (California Endangered Species Act Amended Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2021-015-06 Amendment No. 3 (ITP))

Project Location (include county): County of Riverside, west of the City of Blythe, south of Interstate 10

Project Description: This proposed project involves a minor amendment to the Project Description regarding phasing and associated fencing alignment, as well as reallocation of impact acreage occurring at each Project phase. Additionally, amendments to Conditions of Approval 8.14 and 8.18, and Condition of Approval 9 were made to reflect the changes in acreage associated with each Project Phase and to specify language regarding the use of temporary exclusion fencing for the Covered Species, and use of gates in lieu of guards to exclude the Covered Species at facility entrances.

The amendments to the ITP will not increase the impacts or mitigation as stated in the original ITP. The Project will result in impacts to 1,984 acres of desert tortoise (*Gopherus agassizii*). The project is expected to result in incidental take of desert tortoise, which is designated as an endangered species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
