Project Location/City/County: The project starts approximately 2400 feet south of the intersection of Garden Highway and Second Street and ends approximately 1200 feet south of the intersection of Garden Highway and Second Street between Sutter Butte Flood Control Agency Station 958+95 to Station 971+60, in Sutter County. The United States Corps of Engineers Unit is 144, Levee Mile 12.86 to Levee Mile 13.10.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19332, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: The encroachment consists of two existing 12 kilovolt overhead electrical lines running parallel to levee landside toe with one wood utility pole, guy wire, and anchor located approximately 5 feet from landside levee toe, and four wood utility poles located approximately 30 feet from the landside levee toe in the right bank of the Feather River. This work is associated with Feather River West Levee Project under Permit 18793-1 and was previously constructed in compliance with California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Division 1.

This is to advise that the Board, as the **Responsible Agency**, approved the above-described project on **4/21/23** and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:
