**Project Title:** Vila Borba Off-site Drainage Basin Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0026-R6)

**Project Location:** The project is located at two unnamed drainages, tributaries to Chino Creek and ultimately the Santa Ana River, in the City of Chino Hills within the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 33.938 N, Longitude -117.6785 W. The project is located at Butterfield Ranch Road and Park Crest Drive; Section 1, Township 3S, Range 8W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Prado Dam, San Bernardino; Assessor's Parcel Number 103309124.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0026-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Chino Hills. The project is limited to modifications to a drainage, basin, and associated road culvert in the City of Chino Hills.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on December 1, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
