Project Title: Butterfield Sentinel Quarry Expansion Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0101-R6)

Project Location: The project is located at unnamed tributaries to Holcomb Creek within the San Bernardino National Forest, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Assessors Parcel Numbers 0446-121-04, 0446-121-06, 0446-121-17.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0101-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Omya, Inc., represented by Craig Maetzold. The project is limited to the expansion of the Sentinel and Butterfield Quarries, multi-bench open pit mines, where ore is drilled and blasted about once per week for each quarry. The specific project activities that will impact Fish and Game Code section 1602 resources are the expansion of the B5 Pad, Butterfield Quarry, and Central Area. The project will result in 0.18 acre of permanent impacts to streambed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on January 18, 2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations sections 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
