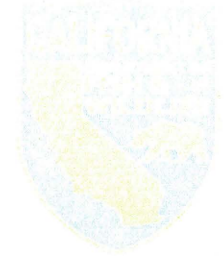

Project Title: Browns Valley Shoulder Widening and Rehabilitation Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0340-R2).

Project Location (include county): Twelve projects are located along State Route (SR) 20 in Yuba County on Dry Creek and unnamed tributaries to the Yuba River. The projects extend between post miles 13.3 and 17.8, approximately 12 miles east of the city of Marysville, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0340-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, State of California Department of Transportation. The larger scope of work includes widening shoulders, realigning a portion of the roadway and replacement of Dry Creek Bridge. The project is limited to repair or replacement of existing culverts, vegetation removal, installation of rock slope protection (RSP), bridge demolition and bridge replacement. This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
