Project Description: The City of Long Beach, in cooperation with Caltrans, is proposing to replace the Shoemaker Bridge (West Shoreline Drive) in the City of Long Beach, California. The proposed project would reconstruct Shoemaker Bridge and realign local street connections to the bridge and to SR-710 corridor. The purpose is to modernize the structure and geometrics of the bridge and to facilitate planned projects adjacent to the bridge.

The FONSI is based on the attached Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment (EIR/EA), which has been independently evaluated by Caltrans and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, environmental issues, and impacts of the proposed Project.
