Project Title: Butte 162 Corridor Improvements Project; EA: 03-2H630 (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0315-R2).

Project Location (include county): Two projects are located along State Route (SR) 162 in Butte County on unnamed tributaries to the Feather River at post miles 18.46 and 19.85 immediately east of Oroville, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0315-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, State of California Department of Transportation. The Project is limited to the extension of one culvert and re-alignment of an existing unnamed tributary to accommodate the new road alignment. This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
