Project Title: San Andreas Reservoir Road Improvement Project (Amended Lake Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SMO-40265-R3)

Project Location (San Mateo County): The project is located on San Andreas Reservoir in the unincorporated portion of the County of San Mateo, State of California; work will occur at four areas along the San Andreas Reservoir shoreline: Latitude 37.602330, N, Longitude -122.427916; 37.603874, N, Longitude -122.429375; 37.606128, N, Longitude -122.43204; 37.581727, N, Longitude -122.410421; and 37.580250, N, Longitude -122.413563.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended the executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SMO-40265-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission as represented by Susan Hou.

This project will provide road improvements along the perimeter of San Andreas Reservoir in order to maintain access to water utility infrastructure, and protect infrastructure from reservoir debris. Project activities include grading and backfilling to reconstruct slopes of the reservoir's eastern shoreline, riprap installations, installation of a soldier-pile wall, replacement of a debris boom anchor, and replacement of two corrugated metal culverts. The Agreement Measure 2.17 was amended to remove prohibition of the use of geotextile material for slope stability if the Permittee monitors for geotextile exposure or migration to the San Andreas Reservoir.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 10, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Final EIR prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
