Project Location (San Mateo County): The project is located at Redwood Creek and San Francisco Bay in the Redwood Creek watershed at 1548 Maple Street, Redwood City, CA 94063, in San Mateo County; latitude 37.49420, Longitude -122.22110; Assessor's Parcel Number (APNs 052-532-070, 052-532-080).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SMO-40041-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, 1548 Maple LLC as represented by Richard Plackter.

The project is limited to: a) the removal of two dilapidated concrete structures that are part of the banks and include portions of structure below the Redwood Creek top of bank; b) remove 0.04 acre (1,637 square feet) of concrete approximately 5 feet landward over a length of approximately 200 feet; c) no new structures nor piles will be installed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on March 11, 2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

- 1. The project **will not h**ave a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
- 2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
- 3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
