Project Description: The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) adopted an Addendum to the previous Environmental Impact Report and approved the renewal of the Clean Harbors San Jose (previously Solvent Services Inc) Hazardous Waste Permit (Permit). The Clean Harbors San Jose (Facility) is a storage and treatment facility for hazardous wastes including solvents and oils and operates under the current permit. The Facility receives more than 1,000 tons of hazardous waste per month and has a current total tank and container storage capacity of 333,365 gallons of hazardous waste. The Facility Permit Renewal reauthorizes continued storage and treatment operations at the facility for an additional ten years. All waste treatment and storage activities are conducted in secondary containment to prevent any waste from running off site. No new construction or expansion of any activities and operations from levels analyzed in the 1990 Final EIR, as amended, are included as part of the permit renewal.

As Responsible Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC approved the above-described project on May 18, 2021 and has made the following determinations:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of project approval.
4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
5. Findings were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
