**Project Title:** Routine Maintenance and Infrastructure Replacement for Waterways in Inyo and Mono Counties (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0113-R6 Amendment 3)


**Project Location:** The Project is located on numerous waterways from the Northern Mono Basin to the Kern County Line, and includes tributaries to Mono Lake, Owens Lake, and Rose Valley Playa, within Inyo and Mono Counties, California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is amending Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0113-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Permittee, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, represented by Adam Perez. The Amendment to the Agreement authorizes additional activities related to dam maintenance, specifically annual inspections of the emergency valves at Long Valley Reservoir as required by the Division of Safety of Dams.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project on December 23, 2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
