PROJECT LOCATION: The Project is located in the city of Carson, along Figueroa Street between West Carson Avenue on the north to West 228th Street on the south, Los Angeles County, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as 216th Street Replacement Trunk Sewer Phase 2. The Project includes the installation of a 54-inch, approximately 5,640-foot-long PVC-lined Rubber Gasket Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RGRCP) sewer line and approximately 12 new manholes.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on January 10, 2023, and determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The Los Angeles County Sanitation District will be carrying out the Project.

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION STATUS:

Class 2: Replacement or Reconstruction

REASON WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The Project has been determined to meet the requirements of the exemption(s) selected above and will not have a significant impact on water quality. The Project involves the replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.
