Project Title: Yarbrough Southport Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-YOL-16982-R3)

Project Location (include county): This project is located in the Main Drain Canal, next to the Sacramento Deep Water Ship Channel, in the County of Yolo, State of California at the following locations:

1. Outfall A: Latitude 38.51890, Longitude -121.56430; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 045-230-004
2. Outfall B: Latitude 38.51650, Longitude -121.57780; APN: 046-190-002
3. Outfall C: Latitude 38.51580, Longitude -121.57950; APN: 045-230-018
4. Outfall D: Latitude 38.51620, Longitude -121.56820; APN: 046-190-003

The project site is located on the east and west sides of Jefferson Boulevard in West Sacramento.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-YOL-16982-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, ASB Southport II, LLC.

The project is limited to the installation of four (4) 60-inch storm drain outfalls into the Main Drain Canal. The outfalls will be of identical design, consisting of a 60-inch reinforced concrete pipe with concreted rock slope protection beginning at the midpoint of the outfall. Loose rock slope protection below the concreted rock slope protection will be backfilled with native soil.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 16, 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were / were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
