The project site is adjacent to the eastern edge of the existing historic downtown area and is separated from it by First Street and the Union Pacific (UPRR) railroad tracks. The site boundaries are roughly Bitterwater Road to the north, the UPRR right-of-way to the west, a portion of San Lorenzo Creek to the south and southeast, and the City's municipal boundary to the east.

The proposed project consists of amending the specific plan, zone changes, lot merger/parcel map and residential development on the Bitterwater/Chestnut Site (Bitterwater Road at Metz Road), and residential and commercial development on the Jayne Street Site and adjacent parcel (Jayne Street at Pearl Street).
