Project Title: County Road 67 Bridge Replacement Projects (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. GLE-48343-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at multiple branches of Howard Slough, in the County of Glenn, State of California; Bridge locations within the project area are: Latitude 39.419963° North, Longitude 121.884591° West; Latitude 39.420131° North, Longitude 121.898013° West; Latitude 39.420172° North, Longitude 121.901966° West, and Latitude 39.420226° North, Longitude 121.905287° West. The Project is located approximately 1.5 miles east of Road Z in Sections 7 and 18, Township 18, North, Range 1 East of the Butte City United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle map.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number GLE-48343-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Glenn County Public Works Agency.

The project consists of the demolition and replacement of four (4) structurally deficient concrete single lane vehicle bridges on County Road 67 and the subsequent replacement of each bridge with a two (2) lane, multi span, cast-in-place concrete slab bridge. The roadway approaches to all bridges will also be reworked to facilitate a smooth transition from the asphalt roadway to each bridge.


This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
