Project Title: Finegan Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0632-R1)


Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Trinity River watershed, approximately 6 miles northwest of the town of Willow Creek, County of Humboldt, and State of California. The project is located in Section 29, T7N, R4E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Willow Creek U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 522-032-004; latitude 40.9699 N and longitude -123.74043 W and latitude 40.96884 N and longitude -123.73937 at the points of culvert replacement (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to 2 encroachments. One encroachment is for replacement of a pre-cultivation 18-inch culvert with a 36-inch culvert. A second encroachment is for replacement of a pre-cultivation 24-inch culvert with a 36-inch culvert. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion and general maintenance during the term of the Agreement. Water for cannabis cultivation is sole sourced from a non-jurisdictional well.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
