**Project Title:** Kinsinger Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0696-R1)


**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 5 miles south of the town of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 35, T01N, 05E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Dinsmore U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 210-141-002 and 210-141-012; latitude 40.42273587 N and longitude 123.5736149 W at the point of diversion.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to five encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Dairy Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The three other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. The fifth proposed encroachment is to decommission a small on-stream pond and restore the stream channel.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.  
CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
