Project Title: McKee Soil Pile Removal Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0363-R1)

Project Location: The project is located approximately one mile east of the Town of Holmes; affecting one Unnamed Tributary to the Eel River in the County of Humboldt, State of California; Section 3, Township 1S, Range 2E; Humboldt Base and Meridian, in the Redcrest, Calif. 7.5-minute quadrangle, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map; Assessor's Parcel Number: 209-351-004.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0363-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Robert McKee. The project consists of one encroachment: One encroachment is for soil pile removal from an Unnamed Tributary to the Eel River. Work for will include using a small excavator, dump truck, and hand tools. Following removal of the soil pile, all exposed bare mineral soil shall be treated for erosion control.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
