Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Salmon Creek watershed, approximately 3.6 miles southwest of the town of Miranda, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 18, T3S, R3E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Miranda and Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 219-041-012; latitude 40.1994 N and longitude 123.8770 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to four encroachments. Two encroachments are for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Salmon Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use, irrigation, and micro-hydro power generation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The two other proposed encroachments are to a poorly installed culvert and to decommission another stream crossing. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
