Work for this encroachment will include excavation, placement of a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Two encroachments are for channel restoration on a Class II and Class III stream. Work for these encroachments include minor excavation, placement of checkdams, and minor rock armoring.
