Project Title: Stillwell Little Buck Mtn Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0181-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the Buck Mountain Creek watershed, approximately 1 mile east of the town of Garberville, County of Humboldt, State of California; Sections 20 and 21, T4S, R4E, Humboldt Base and Meridian, in the Harris and Garberville U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 223-211-004.

Project Description: The project is limited to 2 encroachments. The encroachments are to abandon temporary/fill stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, and stabilization of soils.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
