The project is located in Section 27, T01N, R04E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Larabee U.S. Geological Survey 7.5minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 210-062-006; latitude 40.439210 N and longitude -123.713827 W at the first point of diversion (POD). Project Description: This Agreement relies on the Notification materials and desk review without a CDFW site inspection. The project is limited to 11 encroachments. Four encroachments are for water diversion from springs near unnamed tributaries to Little Larabee Creek. Water is diverted for domestic and irrigation use. Work for the water diversion will include use, replacement, and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The 7 other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts, rock fords, and to decommission historic crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Work for crossing decommissioning includes side channel and channel excavation, reshaping channel and bank, and revegetation with native plants.
