**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

**Project Title:** Pavlov Water Diversion and Pond Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0319-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Salmon Creek watershed, approximately 4 miles southwest of the town of Miranda, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 13, T3S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Miranda U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 219-011-007.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 3 encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Bogus Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use only. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other proposed encroachment are to upgrade a failing stream crossings. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Another encroachment is to stabilize an off-stream pond.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
