**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

**Project Title:** King Standbury Trust Stream Crossing and Pond Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0183-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within Hacker Creek watershed, approximately 6.85 miles west southwest of the town of Phillipsville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 25, T3S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 221-141-015, 221-141-016, and 221-141-017; latitude 40.1771 N and longitude 123.9069 W at the center of the parcels.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 5 encroachments on unnamed tributaries to Hacker Creek. One encroachment is for water diversion for domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other encroachments are to replace existing culverts and to reestablish the natural flow of a pond inlet. Work for these encroachments will include some or all of the following: excavation, culvert removal, culvert replacement, backfilling and compaction of fill, reconstruction of the bed and banks of the stream and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
