Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Lower Eel River watershed, approximately 1.8 miles SW of the town of Blocksburg, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 24, T02S, R04E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Blocksburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 217-381-003 latitude 40.2737 N and longitude 123.6711 W at the first stream crossing.

Project Description: This Agreement relies on the Notification materials and a desk review without a CDFW site inspection. The project is limited to 3 encroachment(s). Work for these encroachment(s) will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
