**Project Title:** Brown Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-14315-R1C)

**Project Location:** The project is located within the Mattole River watershed, at 29330 Mattole Road, town of Petrolia, County of Humboldt, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 105-051-009.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to five (5) encroachments for the use, maintenance, and upgrades of existing stream crossings and a diversion. Work for these encroachments will include regular inspection and clearing of culverts, and excavation, replacement with new properly designed crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
