Project Title: DuPont Water Diversion, Stream Crossings, and Pond Spillway Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-22999-R1)


Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Sproul Creek watershed, approximately 6 miles southwest of the town of Garberville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 16, T05S, R03E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Piercy U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 222-071-030-000; latitude 40.0201 N and longitude 123.8388 W at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to seventeen (17) encroachments. One (1) encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to Sproul Creek. Water is diverted for **domestic** use only. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. One (1) encroachment is for the installation and maintenance of an armored pond spillway. Three (3) encroachments are for the realignment of native channels, removal of failed culverts, remediation, and the decommissioning of an abandoned road. The twelve (12) other proposed encroachments are to upgrade existing culverts that are failing or undersized. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
