Project Title: Neill Water Diversion Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-28066-R1C)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Redwood Creek watershed, approximately 0.6 miles north of the town of Briceland, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 18, T04S, R03E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Briceland U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 220-231-005; latitude 40.1165 N and longitude 123.9010 W at the point of diversion.

Project Description: The project is limited to one encroachment for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to Tank Gulch, a tributary to Redwood Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure.

Determination: This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
