Project Title: Enchanted Forest, South Fork Trinity, Humboldt Cultivation Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TRI-03632-R1)


Project Location (include county): The project is located at the South Fork Trinity River and an Unnamed Tributary in the counties of Humboldt and Trinity, State of California; Latitude 40.848448, Longitude -123.574738; 5690 South Fork Road, Willow Creek, CA, 95573; Assessor's Parcel Number 524-114-011 (Humboldt) and 008-080-034 (Trinity).

Project Description: The project is limited to two encroachments on the South Fork Trinity River and an Unnamed Tributaries. One encroachment is for surface water diversion for domestic use only. Work for the water diversion will include installation use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure in compliance with the Agreement. The other proposed work is to upgrade an existing undersized culvert. Work will include excavation, culvert removal, culvert replacement, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
