**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

**Project Title:** Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-49496-R1C)

**Project Location (include county):** The Project to be completed is located within the Mill Creek – Van Duzen River watershed, approximately 1.8 miles east of the town of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 11, T01N, R05E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Dinsmore U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor’s Parcel Number 208-341-005-000; latitude 40.4864 N and longitude 123.5734 W at the stream crossing.

**Project Description:** The Project is limited to one encroachment. The single proposed encroachment is to maintain an existing culvert. Work for this encroachment will include maintenance and clearing of the inlet and outlet with hand tools only. Currently the inlet is clear of sediment and in good condition, but the outlet needs sediment cleared and potentially addition of rock armoring to stabilize the fill and decrease the perch height. If Permittee cleans the outlet and it is determined the culvert is rusted through, a new culvert shall be installed set to grade including excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
