**Project Title:** Water Diversion (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-51961-R1C)


**Project Location (include county):** The Project to be completed is located within the Middle Mattole River watershed, approximately 5.2 miles southeast of the town of Honewdew, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 29, T03S, R01E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Honeydew U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 107-251-003-000; latitude 40.1739 N and longitude 124.0849 W at the point of diversion (POD).

**Project Description:** The Project is limited to one encroachment. The single encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Fourmile Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include removal of the current diversion infrastructure, replacement with a compliant solution meeting the terms and conditions of this Agreement and use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
