Project Title: Maruska Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-52182-R1C)

Project Location: The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Redwood Creek, in the County of Humboldt, State of California; Latitude 40.9070, Longitude -123.7779; or Section 13, T6N, R3E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Lord-Ellis Summit U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; 355 Old Three Creeks Road, Blue Lake, CA 95525; Assessor's Parcel Number 316-086-020-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-HUM-52182-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Gyle Maruska. The project consists of 2 encroachments: One encroachment is for a stream crossing. Work will include excavation and removal of existing road fill and the placement of rock armoring. One encroachment is for a horizontal well. Work will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. Water is diverted for domestic use. Amendment required with change in use.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
